The Soberano Awards 2015 will take place on Tuesday, April 14 at the Eduardo Brito National Theater of Santo Domingo. Juan Luis Guerra leads the nominations in five areas including songwriter of the year, bachata "TusBesos" ("Your Kisses") popular abroad featured artist, album of the year for "Everything has its time" and video of the year for "Your kisses".

Followed by Romeo Santos, who competes in four boxes: Composer, bachata year with "You're mine," popular abroad featured artist and album of the year ("Formula Vol. 2").

With three nominations each Raulín appear Prince Royce and Rodriguez.
